## **Christmas Hamper Raffle and Non-Uniform Day - Friday 1<sup>st</sup> December**

They cost £1.00 a ticket. On Friday 1<sup>st</sup> December we will be having a non-uniform day to raise funds for the Friends of the School to buy produce for the hamper. If your child would like to wear non-uniform, please send £1.00 into school. The raffle for the hamper will be drawn after the evening Christmas Play performance.

## **Christmas Stay and Play - Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> December**

On Tuesday afternoon at 2pm, Foundation (both nursery and reception) will be having a 'Stay and Play'. Parents or carers are welcome to attend and take part in some Christmas activities. Tables will be set up in groups of four. ## **Coffee and Carols' - Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> December**
